WRRRL President's Report

Welcome back from summer vacation !

First – for the new representatives to the WRRRA and WRRRL, I've received numerous messages which required clarification of the WRRRA and WRRRL meeting dates, so to make sure that everyone understands the difference; the Western Region Ringette League (WRRRL) is a separate entity under the Western Region Ringette Association (WRRRA). The WRRRL is set-up to manage the game schedules for 'regional level' play for U8 through U19 players. We have our own executive, our own rules & procedures and our own mandate. The WRRRL President is also the Second Vice-President of Western Region Ringette Association (WRRRA). Issues related to how our league is run are addressed by the WRRRL executive and membership.

The WRRRL has not had our first meeting for the 2013-2014 season.

We set the schedule for this coming season at the AGM in April based on when associations would be able to declare their teams and start their season. There are upcoming deadlines and requirements which everyone needs to be aware of, please see the attached schedule. All Associations must have representation at the meeting on October 1st.

As well, several items were discussed at the AGM and our policies need to be modified or established at the first meeting. Please review the AGM minutes, if you need input from coaches or other executive members please get it before the meeting. Come ready to make a decision.

As of October 1, 2013, there will be two openings on the WRRRL Executive, the Eastern Convenor position remains open and the President's chair (which includes Second VP of WRRRA). All Associations in WRRRL are asked to take their turn on the executive, to date there are several that have not done so. If someone does not step forward on October 1st, I will be 'pulling a name out of a hat' for the President's position.

Oct. 19, 2013 – games will begin

Dec. 6, 2013 – ice times due to schedulers for January to March 2014

Dec. 12, 2013 – WRRL Meeting (location and time to be confirmed)
