We will once again be using the arbiter software to schedule refs this season. Heather Verhoeve has offered to continue managing the software program. Heather will be scheduling league games only for A/AA, any exhibition games and U12 games your local referee in chief is responsible to find refs. They can still contact me for assistance in finding the appropriate people if they need help. Scheduling of B and C refs will also be done by local RICs.

This is not a rules change year therefore coaches are not required to attend a rules clinic. However if any association would like a rules clinics for parents, coaches or players send me an email and I can arrange for an instructor to come to you for the clinic.

We are hosting three clinics for new referees and three clinics for referees wishing to move up in rank. Associations should be encouraging their existing refs to take these clinics as we continue to work on developing our refs to a higher level of caliber. Ringette Canada is proposing separating the level 2 and 3 clinic so if a referee gets their clinic now it will avoid them having to go to an extra clinic.
