

November 21, 2019 Adult Coordinator Report

Hi Everyone,

We have had a great first couple of months to start the season. I wanted to share a couple updates and reminders for teams as we get further into the season.

1. The OAIC is currently scheduled to be held in Oshawa over the Easter Weekend for the 2020 season. The tournament will start April 9 and run until April 11, to give everyone Easter Sunday at home with their families. A formal registration package will be available for everyone in the next week or so. It will be running 18+ BB, B, CC, and C division.
2. Regular Tournament Play
 - a. It is important to note that you have been accepted to tournaments before you have submitted payment and schedules for tournaments are confirmed 4 weeks beforehand. There is an enforced fee for dropping out of tournaments after you have been accepted.
 - i. This does not apply if the tournament has to shift your team to a different division than you registered for to run the tournament. However if you have been reseeded mid year, the rule above applies.
3. Tournament Substitutions
 - a. I can sign all TRF Adjustment forms for tournaments, please have them to me 2 weeks before the tournament starts, or 2 days before in case of emergency.
 - i. If your substitution involves an out of region player, please share with me and I will loop in the ADC from that Region to also sign-off. The tournament host ADC only needs to sign-off if there happens to be an in tournament substitution is required and I am not available.
 - b. A quick reminder of the rules. Players are able to substitute in 2 tournaments and are only able to play in one tournament/weekend. Goalies are able to substitute in 3 tournaments and again can only play in one tournament/weekend.
 - c. You are able to substitute either up one level or at the same level of your team (IE a B player can sub for a B /BB or A team, a C player can substitute for C/CC or B team)
