

WRRRA AGM Report Sport Development Committee April 2012

There were a number of new initiatives put in place this year including the Skills Matrix, Team Activity Log and the Fair Ice Policy.

Our region had 127 teams between U9 and U19AA this season.

Team Activity Log

Every team from U9 to U19AA is required to enter all team activities (including league, tournament, and exhibition games, team meetings, team parties, practices, etc) into the team activity log. The team representative responsible for the Team Activity Log must enter the date of the activity, the duration (in hours) of the activity; select the type of activity from the drop down menu. If the activity is a game, the home and away teams must be entered. If the activity was not a game, a description must be entered in the home team column.

Each team is required to submit their Team Activity Log at the end of their season. If any team in your association (U9 to U19AA) has not already submitted their Team Activity Log please do so as soon as possible. We have received less than 50% of the Team Activity Log's required.

Skills Matrix

All U8, U9 and U10 teams were asked to submit their Skills Matrix for their teams for this season and most teams complied but not all. This will be required again next season so please advise your coaches.
