The WRRA AGM this past July went well, the region was able to update our current bylaws to help reflect changes to the approach to voting in directors, enacting new committees, and establishing new important roles for our region. I look forward to seeing how we as a region can engage these athletes better in our region.

I would like to thank all Executive and Directors for all the work they have done and are about to do to get this season off the ground. I want to ask all association executives, specifically the presidents to be patient with how we move forward this year, specifically around how covid-19 and vaccination mandates are being managed. I know it is taking longer than associations would like, however the issues as very complex and ever changing. With the most recent announcements from the Ontario Gov. and feedback from legal experts there is a lot of coordination work we will have to do as leagues, coaches, and associations to give the athletes the best experience possible this season.
