

## **WRRA 2022 AGM Coaching Report**

Although the 2021-2022 season had a more "normal" feel than the previous season, the region certainly faced many challenges related to coaching this season.

The pandemic's negative impacting on volunteering, coupled with losing some coaches that did not comply with the RO vaccination policy resulted in significant pressure on the ability of some teams to form a bench staff that met RO's requirements. The rule that managers are not permitted on the bench for games was withdrawn for the season at the regional level. Consideration was also given to permit teams to participate in games provided they had a female on the bench, the female did not have to be a coach.
