- 3) Correction to previous minutes
  - i) Nancy noted that WRIARA had attended but had not been included within the Association Roll Call.
- 4) Motion to approve the minutes from previous meeting Chris Sharpe Guelph/Dorchester, Carried
- 5) Reports
  - a) Officiating Coordinator Denise Pelletier
    - i) Verbal report provided.
    - ii) RO running clinics and Level 1 & 2 have been provided although unable to do onice portion.
    - iii) Recent conference call with RO held to discuss issues around officiating & game play:
      - RO recommending: 5-on-5 play, and that play should look like ringette (ie use of blue lines).
      - Officials to look for 'prolonged contact' and limit play against the boards. When called, the ring will be turned over to the other team.
      - Working with RO to clear up inconsistencies in language and in the understanding of modified games rules.
      - Pulling the goalie is allowed in modified play
      - Associations don't need to use team jerseys but if jerseys do not have numbers, they will not know who scored or who may have had multiple penalties in a game.
