

## **FINE SUMMARY**

- Play without Approved Roster Any regular season or playoff games scheduled or played, without an approved Roster, or in contravention of the approved Roster, will be recorded as forfeited regardless of the outcome of games played. The team will also be fined \$50.00 for each non-rostered player and for any non-rostered team official, who participated in any games played.
- Game Cancellations Where a game is cancelled with less than three (3) school days'
  notice for reasons other than stated in Policy Manual Article H, the cancelling team, at
  the sole discretion of the Executive, may be financially responsible for the ice fees and/or
  Referees' fees for the cancelled game; and/or may be required to forfeit that game.

Other special cases will be at the sole discretion of the League. Generally, the League will not be responsible for the ice costs associated with cancelled games, unless the League was responsible for the ice costs, such as final playoff games.

Where a team chooses not to follow the procedures outlined in this Article H, the team will be levied a \$50.00 fine for the first offense and a \$75.00 fine for the second and subsequent offenses. The fine will be taken from the team's performance bond and, consequently, the team is not eligible to play until the fine has been paid.

- Reporting Scores Any home team who fails to report the game score within the stated time will be fined \$20 for each offence. The fine must be paid in full prior to the start of the next League game or that game and any subsequent games will be forfeited until the debt is paid regardless of whether they were played.
- League meetings: The failure to have a League member at each league meeting shall result in the following fines: first missed meeting- \$50.00 fine, second and subsequent meetings in the same season- \$75.00
- Roster Labels: Starting with the first league game and ending with the last playoff game, all teams must use a player roster sticker to be added to the official game sheets. Failure to do so will result in a fine: first offense- \$25, second offense- \$50, further offenses- \$100 each.
- Team & Player Photos: Teams will no longer be required to attend at Keith Bodley Arena for photos but must supply photos in the League approved format no later than the approved deadline each year (near 3<sup>rd</sup> week October). Failure to meet the deadline will result in a \$200.00 fine.
