

## YMH Kinsmen Arena Protocol as of Oct 30, 2020

1. **Review the Pre-activity Screening prior to coming to the rink - <http://bit.ly/YMHprescreen>.**  
**Stay home if you are sick. Those showing symptoms of COVID-19 are advised to contact the Saskatchewan Healthline at 811 for further guidance.**  
**Persons under a Saskatchewan Health order to isolate or quarantine are not allowed into the arena.**
2. **ALL PERSONS NOT ON THE SURFACE, MUST BE MASKED.** Person's who choose not to follow the face mask protocol may be subject to team ice suspension and/or have ice privileges suspended or removed for the player or team.
3. Maintain physical distancing (6 feet or 2 metres) from those not within your household, or extended household.
4. Limit time spent in the facility. Do not congregate in common areas such as lobbies, hallways, etc.
5. Each team **MUST HAVE** a COVID Designate. The COVID Designate must be present at the entrance of the arena while any participants are entering the arena to ensure complete contact tracing. Once the door is closed it will be locked for the duration of the ice session. The COVID Designate is expected to monitor spectator behavior at all times. If no COVID Designate has volunteered to assist, the ice will be unavailable for use. If the ice time cannot be re-allocated, the team will still be charged for the ice time.
6. Upon entering the arena, the Team COVID Designate will log **ALL** individuals attending the ice session. This log must include, First and Last Name and Contact Phone Number. This log must be turned into YMH following the ice session.
7. On Ice participants (players and coaches) are required to wear a face mask until they are wearing a helmet and going on ice. Helmets will not be donned until individuals are actually going out to the ice surface.
8. The sharing of water bottles is prohibited.
9. Game day workers must be masked.

### 10. **PRACTICES & GAMES**

#### **Entry to Kinsmen Arena**

- Dressing Room assignments and entrance designations will be posted on the main front door. All participants are to enter the Kinsmen Arena through the indicated doors and check-in with the COVID Designates.
- Participants may arrive at the facility no more than 30 minutes before the schedule time.
- Spectators will enter the arena through the assigned entrance as posted: either the East (emergency exit from the arena – by the east bleachers) or West (emergency exit from the arena – by the DJ booth)
- Parents/Guardians/Spectators may arrive 15 minutes before the schedule time

#### **Dressing rooms**

- Team personnel and players should be the only persons in dressing rooms (players, coaches, medical staff/trainers). If a parent is required for skate tying purposes, only one parent per player will be permitted. They must be masked and must immediately vacate the dressing room once skates are tied.
- Teams must exit the dressing rooms within 15 mins of the end of the ice session.

## **YMH Kinsmen Arena Protocol as of Oct 23, 2020 con't**

### **Exit from Kinsman Arena**

- All persons should exit the arena using the same door they entered within 15 mins of the end of the ice session.

### **11. CAPACITY INFORMATION**

- Practice/Game Participant numbers (includes players, coaching staff, game day workers) is as per SK Hockey guidelines. Please reach out to your YMH Liaison for any clarification required on numbers and/or masking policies.
- Maximum Spectators is 60 for the facility (for practice or game). All spectators must wear a mask and be socially distanced from any other person not in their household group. Spectators must stand in pre-marked areas on bleachers. Standing areas are closed.
- Parents/Guardians are reminded that children must be with them at all times. Children are not allowed to roam around the facility unsupervised. Each spectator must stay in their designated spot.

### **12. TAKE NOTE**

- Person's who choose not to follow the face mask protocol may be subject to team ice suspension and/or have ice privileges suspended or removed for the player or team.
- It is the Team COVID Designate responsibility to ensure that all guidelines are followed.
- Failure to adhere to these guidelines could result in removal from the arena and sanctions against the Team.
